## Year 11 Parents' Evening 2024

The Year 11 Parents' Evening is scheduled for October 17<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> 2024. Like all of our Parents' Evenings the meetings will take place virtually on the SchoolCloud system, meaning that you will log in at a pre-arranged time.

SchoolCloud bookings can be made from 6.00p.m on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

Where group sizes allow, it is our hope that students will make appointments with all teachers who teach a particular course. Where this is not the case some of the options will be pre-set to teachers who have information about the whole course.

To allow us to offer as many appointments as possible we must limit them to one appointment in each subject per household.
